Washington, D.C. – The U.S. Conference of Mayors has POSTPONED release of its 2015 Hunger and Homelessness Survey until early next week.

For more than a quarter century, The Conference of Mayors has reported on the shortage of emergency services – food, shelter, medical care, income and energy assistance -- as well as the programs offered by many cities to help people in need, with the goal of bringing national attention to the causes of hunger and homelessness in cities across the country.
